SATURDAY 17 MAY

10.45am - 4.45pm WALK Meet at Ballasalla station, walk to Santon gorge to see crosses on beach and visit Ballawoods keeill. Then past a burial ground to Santon church on a keeill site, and crosses. On to Santon railway station to catch train back to Ballasalla. Bring picnic lunch. (Optional travel by train to/from Douglas/Port Erin.)

SUNDAY 18 MAY

3pm - KIRK BRADDAN Worship in the three sites at Braddan.

MONDAY 19 MAY

11am - CAR CROSS-CRAWL Meet at Bride parish church (please use the public car park opposite the church) then drive to Andreas to look at fine collection of crosses. Optional pub lunch at Andreas.

MONDAY 19 MAY

7.45pm ILLUSTRATED TALK "The Saints of the Keeills" by local historian Frank Cowin at Promenade Methodist Church Hall, Douglas.

TUESDAY 20 MAY

10.30am - 4pm WALK Meet at Glen Mooar beach car park (map ref 303894). Walk through Glen Mooar to Cabbyl Pherick keeill, then along Staarvey road, passing Keeill Pherick a Dromma, and returning along coastal footpath. Bring picnic lunch.

WEDNESDAY 21 MAY

6.30pm WALK AROUND MAROWN Meet at Crosby Methodist chapel. Walk up to Keeill Vreeshey then via green lane to St Trinians, returning along the old railway line.

THURSDAY 22 MAY

2.30pm VISIT TO LANGNESS Meet at Castletown Golf Links hotel car park. Walk over to St Michael's Isle with its fort and keeill, followed by optional afternoon tea.

FRIDAY 23 MAY

9pm VISIT TO MAUGHOLD. Simple supper in church hall, followed by candlelight pilgrimage around the three churchyard keeills.

SATURDAY 24 MAY

10.30am - 4pm WALK Meet at Sloc car park (map ref 216734). Talk and service near the Sloc, then cliff top walk to Fleshwick, overlooking site of St Patrick's landing place. Returning via Surby, passing keeill site. Stout footwear required - steep and difficult terrain. Bring picnic lunch.
